

## Beach (Lake Access) Ordinance

VILLAGE OF CHIPPEWA-ON-THE-LAKE  
ORDINANCE NO. 403-91

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 148 (BEACH RULES) TO REVISE AND UPDATE THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR USE OF THE BEACH AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS:

THE VILLAGE PARKS COMMITTEE HAS RECOMMENDED UPDATED AND REVISED RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR USE OF THE BEACH LOCATED IN THE VILLAGE OF CHIPPEWA-ON-THE-LAKE TO COUNCIL, AND COUNCIL CONCURS THAT SUCH REVISED RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE ADVISABLE AND NECESSARY,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHIPPEWA-ON-THE-LAKE, OHIO, THREE-FOURTHS OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING THEREIN:

SECTION I:

Ordinance No. 148 regulating the use of the bathing beach of Chippewa-on-the-Lake, Ohio is hereby amended to replace the Rules and Regulations stated in said Ordinance No. 148 with the following Rules and Regulations which shall govern the use of the bathing beach of Chippewa-on-the-Lake:

1. The hours of the beach shall be from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Eastern Daylight Savings Time, seven (7) days a week from Memorial Day through Labor Day.
2. The use of the beach shall be limited to residents of the Village of Chippewa-on-the-Lake and other persons issued passes under Rule 4 hereof and/or their guests. A guest is defined as a person visiting the Chippewa-on-the-Lake resident's home, that eats, sleeps and changes into bathing suits in that owner's home. All Village residents and their guests must register at the main entrance of the beach with the beach attendant.
3. All residents desiring to use the beach must obtain a beach pass from the Parks Committee of the Council of the Village of Chippewa-on-the-Lake. Residents must sign a beach pass application acknowledging that they have read and understand this ordinance prior to receiving a beach pass.
4. Beach passes will be offered to residents of Briarwood Beach and residents of Lafayette Township in an area bordered by Longacre Drive, County Rd. 19, County Rd. 50 and the Village of Chippewa-on-the-Lake corporate limits.
5. The Council of Chippewa-on-the-Lake through the

Parks Committee reserves the right to revoke a beach pass and beach privileges due to violation of beach rules and/or destruction or abuse of beach or Village park property.

6. Alcoholic beverages including beer, wine, liquor and any other beverage containing alcohol is prohibited on the beach and in the beach parking lot.
7. Cans, bottles and glass containers are strictly prohibited in the beach area and the beach parking lot.
8. Picnics in the beach area are restricted to the southern most part of the beach only. Open fires of any kind are prohibited in the beach area. Picnic fires are permitted in provided fire grills in the picnic area only.
9. Dogs and other domestic animals are prohibited in the beach area and the beach water area.
10. Boating, jet skiing, water skiing and fishing are prohibited within twenty (20) feet of the bathing area.
11. Ball playing on the beach shall be restricted to the southern most part of the beach and only in designated areas. No baseball, football or soccer playing is allowed in the beach area. Ball playing in the beach water is permitted at the discretion of the beach attendants.
12. Playing tag and pushing on the beach wall and/or the diving platform is prohibited.
13. Diving off the diving platform ladder and the beach wall is prohibited.
14. Profane or abusive language shall be prohibited in the beach area.
15. A child ten (10) years of age or younger must be accompanied and supervised by a person of senior high school age or older while in the beach area.
16. Innertubes and life rafts are prohibited beyond the inner beach ropes.
17. All refuse must be placed in rubbish containers.
18. Beach attendants are not life guards. NO

LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY IN THE BEACH AREA AT ANY TIME.

**NOTE: BECAUSE NO LIFEGUARD IS PROVIDED, SWIMMING AT THE BEACH IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.**

19. Motorized vehicles and bikes are prohibited in the beach area.
20. Loitering in the beach parking area before and after beach hours is prohibited.
21. Parking in the beach area parking lot is restricted to owners of vehicles with beach parking passes only. Beach parking passes must be displayed on the front dashboard or on the front windshield of the vehicle, in clear view for the police. Boat and jet ski trailers are prohibited in the beach parking area at all times.
22. Any person violating any of the foregoing rules and regulations for use of the beach of Chippewa-on-the-Lake, Ohio shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00. Repeat offenders may have their beach pass revoked for the current and/or future bathing seasons by the Village of Chippewa-on-the-Lake, Ohio.

SECTION II:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the safety and welfare of the Village of Chippewa-on-the-Lake, Ohio and its inhabitants by reason of the need to have updated and revised Rules and Regulations for the use of the Village beach in effect in advance of the time of opening the beach for the 1991 season, and this ordinance shall go into immediate operation and effect.
