ORDINANCE NO. 492-99

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 356-86 WITH RESPECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR USE OF THE VILLAGE TENNIS AND BASKETBALL COURTS, AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHIPPEWA LAKE, OHIO:

SECTION I: Violation of any of the rules and regulations which govern the use of the Village tennis courts and Village basketball court set forth in Ordinance No. 356-86 shall be a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION II: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the public safety, health and welfare of the Village of Chippewa Lake and its inhabitants by reason of the immediate need for enforcement capability of the rules which govern the use of the Village tennis courts and basketball court, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate operation and effect.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TIMES FOR OPENING AND CLOSING OF
PARKS IN THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHIPPEWA LAKE,
MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO as follows:

SECTION I: The times for opening and closing of all parks within the Village shall be:

1. For the Beach from 10:00 a.m. until dark (with dark defined as the time street lights in the Village go on), seven (7) days a week from Memorial Day through Labor Day.
2. For all other parks within the Village from 8:00 a.m. until dark (with dark defined as the time streetlights go on in the Village).

SECTION II: Ordinance Nos. 356-86, setting forth rules and regulations for the tennis court and basketball courts, and 403-91, setting forth beach rules, are hereby amended to the extent of the change herein of opening and closing of those areas. No other provisions or terms of those Ordinances are affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION III: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the safety, health and welfare of the Village of Chippewa Lake and its inhabitants by reason of the immediate need to have revised times for opening and closing of parks within the Village which are consistent and capable of immediate enforcement, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate operation and effect.
