

## **REMINDER – ANNUAL CLEAN UP DAY**

8700 Lake Road (north of TA Truckstop)

Lafayette Twp. and Village of Chippewa Lake residents are encouraged to beautify our community by bringing your unwanted trash to the annual clean-up day.

Residents may be asked to provide proof of residency.

Please use the south entrance (look for signs)

Free Disposal Items include: general trash, freon free appliances, scrap metal, furniture, fluorescent bulbs, computers, printers, monitors, old-style, up to two TV monitors, or monitors (CRT) (more than two for \$5 each), batteries, used oil-placed in plastic gallon jugs (no mixtures, gasoline or antifreeze), and old yard equipment (tanks must be drained) and up to four passenger tires (no rims or off road tires). Additional passenger tire disposal available for \$1.50 each.

Items not accepted include: appliances containing Freon, medications, syringes, off road tires, tires on rims, cell phones and fax machines.

No shredding at this event. Shredding will be provided at another event at a later date to be announced.
