

DANDELION TOUR

Chippewa Lake Ohio Historical Society will be participating in the Medina County Historical Society's annual Dandelion Tour this year. There will be two locations in the area - at the Village Inn and Duecker's cottage/museum at the entry of the former Chippewa Lake Park where visitors can view artifacts and share memories of the area.

The tour will be held on Sunday, May 19 from noon to 5 p.m. Also included are stops at the Northern Ohio Railway Museum on Buffham Road, the Seville Historical Society and the Wadsworth Historical Society. Maps are available at any of the stops. Visitors are encouraged to get their map stamped and by visiting all four stops, will be eligible for entry for a gift card drawing.

The first 25 visitors to each of the Chippewa stops will receive a commemorative Chippewa Lake Park paper cup. Food and drink will be available at The Village Inn; water at the Park site. The Chippewa Lake Historical Society will also have t-shirts and books available for purchase.

The parade line-up will start at 12:00 noon on Thursday July 4,2019 and the parade will start promptly at 1:00 p.m. The parade begins at Gloria Glens Town Hall on Lake Road and ends at Lions Park. The route is a little over a mile of flat pavement.

Our parade judges will be two members of the "All American Judges Association." This group has been doing a fine job for us for many years. As you all know, they have a big job in sorting out all the different entries in a short period of time, and they seem to handle this very well. Trophies were awarded last year in some of the following categories: Best of Parade, Most Original Entry, Best Color Guard and Jr. Color Guard, Best Girl Scout or Boy Scout Entry, Best Commercial Entry, various 4-H Entries, Best Military Unit, various Float Entries, Best Horse, Best Animal and Best Draft Horse Units, Best Classic/Antique/Street Rod entries, Best Antique Truck and Fire Truck and various Fire and Rescue Units. This year some special Theme trophies may be added. This trophy list is subject to change depending on the type and the number of entries received.

All Antique and Classic Vehicles that enter by June 10, 2019 will receive a DASH PLAQUE. The other units that wish to qualify for a trophy should send their entry by June 15, 2019. Last minute entries will be accepted up until the start of the parade, but we cannot guarantee that you will qualify for a trophy. Trophies and plaques will be awarded immediately following the

parade and recipients of the same must be present.
