WEST NILE ALERT

The Mayor of Chippewa received the following information related to West Nile Virus. Questions should be forwarded to Steve Mazek (information below)

Mayor Dodaro and Mr. Eppink:

Our office was notified today, by the Ohio Department of Health, that one of our mosquito trapping locations tested positive for West Nile virus. This particular trap is located at 6105 Chippewa Road, just north of the Chippewa Inlet South parking lot. The collection day for the trap was July 2, 2019. In response to this positive pool for West Nile virus, the Medina County Health Department will be increasing our treatment and surveillance of mosquitoes in the Chippewa Lake Village area. Our staff will be increasing larviciding efforts to try and control future mosquito hatches. This will include treating catch basins that hold water, with extended release larvicide tablets and treating accessible marshy areas with a granulated formula larvicide. Large, marshy areas are beyond our ability to treat, but we can treat smaller areas found throughout the Village. It is our recommendation that any efforts already underway by the Village to control adult mosquitoes, such as evening ULV spraying, that these treatments be increased to help aid in reducing the adult population of mosquitoes.

We will begin treatment of the area on Tuesday, July 16, 2019. If you should have any questions or concerns, please let me know.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION about WEST NILE VIRUS

Symptoms and signs of **West Nile virus** include fever, headache, body aches, skin rash, and swollen lymph nodes. Severe **symptoms** and signs may include stiff neck, sleepiness, disorientation, coma, tremors, convulsions, and paralysis. Most cases of **West Nile virus infection** are mild and go unreported. While pets can contract **West Nile virus** (WNV), the CDC states that only a small number of **dogs** and cats with WNV have been reported. The symptoms are generally confined to a light **fever** and lethargy. ... Stay inside (and keep your pets with you) around dawn and dusk when mosquitoes are often most active.
