

Reminder of Golf Cart safety activities in Chippewa Lake.

Golf carts are a wonderful and safe way to get around the Chippewa Lake community and are growing in popularity. In 2020 alone, there have been 15 new golf cart inspections. But here are a couple of reminders so we can safely enjoy and avoid unnecessary problems.

1. Golf Carts are licensed vehicles by the State of Ohio and need to be inspected prior to receiving your license plates. Simply call Sheriff Dispatch at 330-725-0028 and they will arrange for a Deputy to come out for the safety inspection.
2. Also, golf carts are an Ohio licensed motor vehicle and therefore require a properly licensed driver to safely operate this vehicle.
3. Properly display your Chippewa Lake parking pass when parking in Village parking lots.
4. Unlicensed minors will be ticketed.
5. Should there be an accident, parents will have major liabilities issues and if there are injuries....it gets really ugly from there.... just don't do it.
6. When leaving your golf cart parked and unattended, make sure to remove the key.
 - a. Unfortunately, we recently had golf cart illegally moved without the owner's permission. We don't need those problems anymore.
7. **What to do and who to contact when seeing any illegal activities within the Village.**
 - a. **First**, make sure you are safe.
 - b. **Second**, try and have the presence of mind to get picture or write down license plate number; color, make, and model of vehicle involved, accurate description of individuals involved (sex, age, height, weight, hair color, clothing and etc.)
 - c. **If this is an emergency situation, immediately call 911.**
 - d. **If a non-emergency**, call the Medina County Sheriff Dispatch at 330-725-0028. The closest Deputy will respond quickly.
8. Other safety issues can be reported to Alan Robbins, Village Council - Committee Chair for Safety and Fire at 330-701-7879.

IMPORTANT NOTE- **Golf carts CANNOT be operated on Lake Rd.** due to the speed limit for golf carts (under 25 mph). WE APOLOGIZE for inviting you to golf cart to CrossPointe Church for services.... but you can still come by car. Be safe and enjoy our wonderful Chippewa Lake community.

NO PARKING REMINDER

There is no car, truck or boat parking on any of the lakefront property, public or private.... unless it is a designated parking lot. Recently, there have been some violations. Golf carts and bicycles can be positioned on this green space. Other vehicles can only be TEMPORARILY positioned on the green space for taking docks in/ out.
