EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

Community Action Wayne/Medina is offering additional emergency assistance for homeowners and renters in Wayne and Medina Counties affected by Coronavirus (COVID-19). CAW/M may be able to assist households:

- Facing eviction or late notice from their landlord;
- Are experiencing imminent homelessness;
- Mortgage delinquency or forbearance unable to pay their mortgage and have verification of past due payment;
- Threat of disconnection of utilities

Rental arrears, mortgage delinquencies and past due utility amounts from April 1, 2020 may be paid only if there is a COVID-related reason.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Families and individuals in Wayne and Medina Counties who meet the following criteria.

- Must be able to prove financial hardship as a result of COVID-19, and
- Income is at or below 80% Average Median Income for their county (approximately \$56,000 for a family of four in Wayne County and \$60,000 for a family of four in Medina County), and
- Past due rent, mortgage or utility payments due to COVID-related hardship.

Individuals may be eligible for additional assistance even if previously assisted with PHASE 1 if they still meet all qualifications.
