As we continue to try our best to serve our Chippewa Lake community and friends in a safe, efficient way, the meal will be available TAKE OUT only. If you do NOT have transportation to come to CrossPointe to pick up a meal, you may call the church office at 330-975-4309 by Saturday, October 23rd to request delivery to your home. This is a service provided by CrossPointe volunteers, so is available only if needed, and only in the Chippewa Lake/Gloria Glens area. The meal will be served on Friday, October 29th, from 5PM to 6:00PM. If you would like to enjoy this wonderful meal, please observe these very important instructions: come to CrossPointe between 5 and 6PM on Friday, October 29th and follow the directions of the volunteer at the entrance to the parking lot. A CrossPointe volunteer will come to your car to ask how many meals you would like to have. Another volunteer will then bring the number of meals you need out to your car. This procedure is being enacted to ensure your safety as well as that of our volunteers during this COVID outbreak.
