***GriefShare Support starting January 18th at 12:30 PM
at CrossPointe Community Church***

Now, more than ever, people who are hurting from the pain of losing a loved one need support. The current health crisis has added stress, anxiety, and isolation to an already painful situation. A grief support group can give participants the hope they need to make it through this crisis. GriefShare is a nondenominational, biblical support group that focuses on helping people who are dealing with a loved one’s death. Each DVD session features nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories, followed by small group discussion about the topics presented (with workbook support).

At each GriefShare session you will find encouragement and help in grieving the death of your loved one. No matter the cause of your loved one’s death, this is an opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling. You will learn how to cope with the normal emotions that come when grieving a death. You will learn valuable information on facing life situations, and you’ll gain renewed hope for the future. These

sessions are open to any adult regardless of whether your experience is recent or not so recent.
