LAKE WATER TESTING

Save the Lake is testing devices designed to help eliminate nutrients and muck. Nutrients source vegetation and algae. The devices have been used in smaller bodies of water with success. We want to see applicability along the shoreline. These devices are installed at the northeast end of the lake and have a buoy attached. Please do not disturb them. Thank you!
