JULY 4th, 2023 at The Chippewa Lake Ski Team Show Dock, AFTER ski show PRIZES for fastest boat, most creative for Jr. & Sr. divisions ENTRY FEE IS \$10.00 per boat. Pick up entry at Chippewa Beverage or 244 Clover Cliff Dr. {Entries will be on the porch} or register before ski show Official Rules:

- ONLY paper, cardboard, duct tape, adhesive, water based paint
- Cardboard may be corrugated, but may not have a wax , resin, or vinyl coating
- Wood, plastic, plastic wrap, fiberglass, metal, Styrofoam, or other materials which would aid flotation or rigidity are prohibited
- Duct or clear packing tape, liquid nail adhesive, and contact rubber cement are ok.
- Tar, wax, silicone, fiberglass resins, epoxy glues, staples, nails, clamps and screws are prohibited
- Decorations may be made of any material but cannot help keep the boat together or afloat
- Boats may be painted with water based paint or sealer, like Thompson's Water Seal Stain. All paint and sealer must be dry before entering the water
- Oars, paddles, or wind may be used to propel the boat- they may be made out of any material
- All participants must wear personal floatation devices throughout the race
- Passengers in the boat must not be enclosed above the shoulders, and must be visible while the boat is in the water
- Each team must remove the entire boat or its remains from the water at the conclusion of the race. A dumpster will be provided for disposal.
