Chippewa Lake Closed on Monday, August 14 for Treatment -- Weather Permitting

Medina County Park District staff will be treating Chippewa Lake for a mild bloom of cyanobacteria, weather permitting, on Monday, August 14. The lake will be closed Monday morning beginning at 9 a.m. through Monday afternoon at 3 p.m. during the treatment process. Recent water samples from Chippewa Lake indicate an increasing level of cyanobacteria that can cause harmful algal blooms that are capable of producing and releasing harmful toxins into the water. Chippewa Lake is closely monitored for cyanobacteria blooms and toxins. Results from the most recent water sample analyzed (8/8) indicate microcystin toxin levels at 0.258 ug/L. While this is well below the recommended threshold (8 ug/L) for a Recreational Public Health Advisory, it is important to treat blooms proactively before toxin levels become a concern. Park staff will apply Lake Guard Blue, a U.S. EPA approved and NSF/ANSI-60 certified product, to Chippewa Lake. It is the same treatment used in August 2019 that proved to be successful. Lake Guard Blue's biodegradable coat enables the product to float on the surface of the water, traveling to the affected location where it releases its active ingredient causing oxidative stress and major damage to algae and cyanobacteria populations – in this case, by interrupting their photosynthetic activity or by binding to their cellular enzymes. The active ingredient in the treatment is copper sulfate, which has long been used around the world as a safe and effective algaecide. While there are no use restrictions on this product, the park district is recommending that people and pets avoid contact with the water until results are received for a toxin analysis following treatment of the lake (results should be available by 8/18). Boating and fishing are permitted during this time, but direct contact with the water should be minimized. Thank you for your cooperation.
