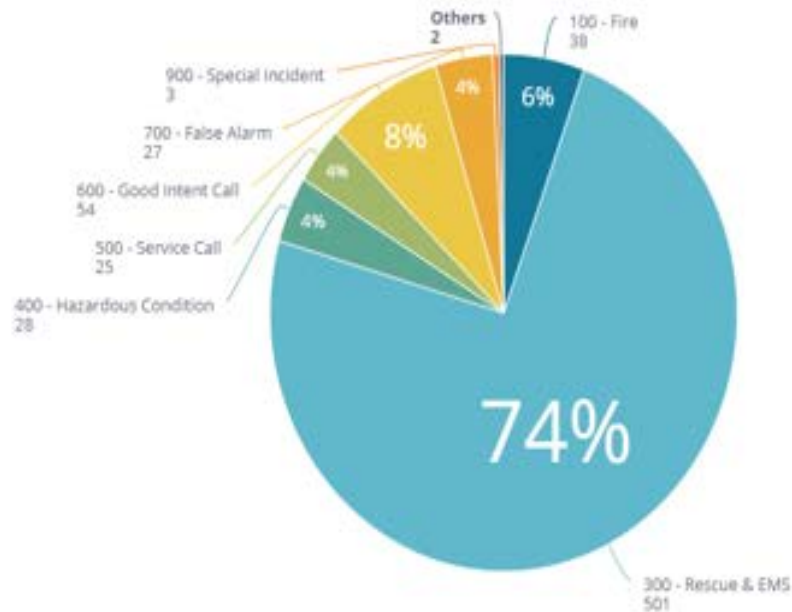

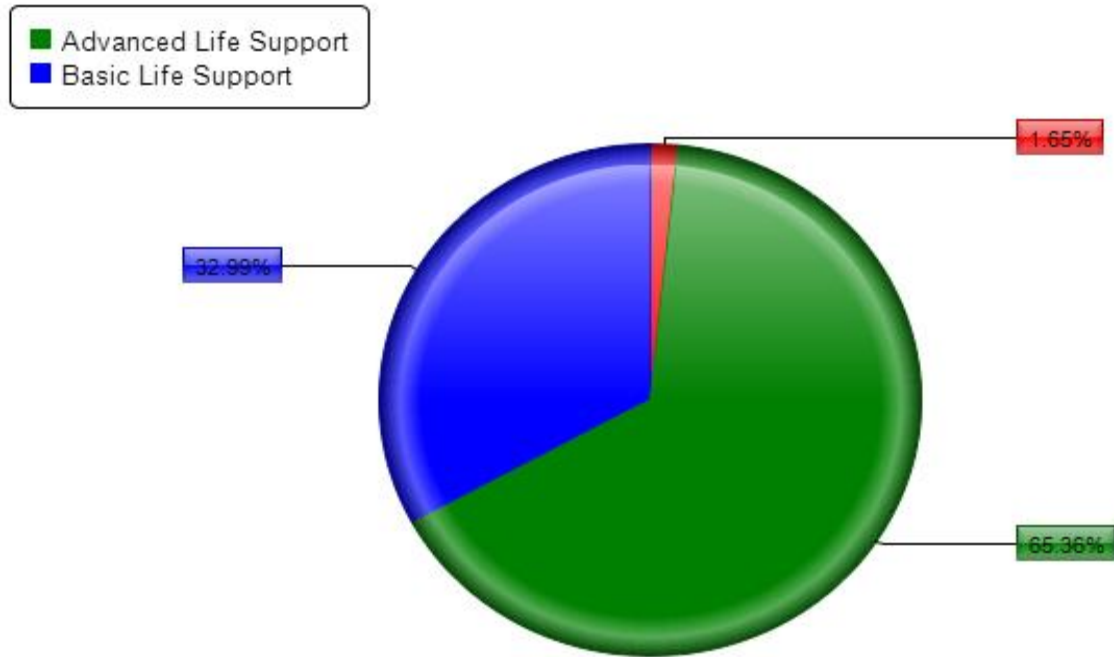
2023 Run Statistics

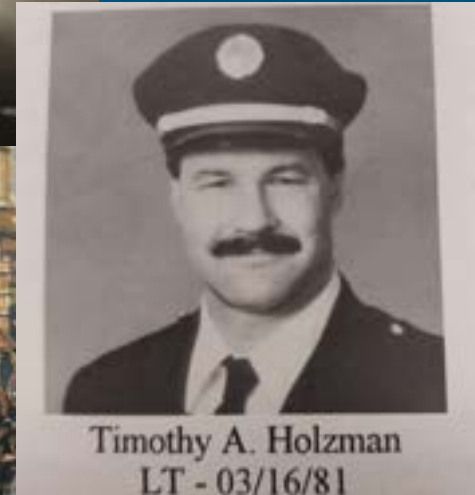

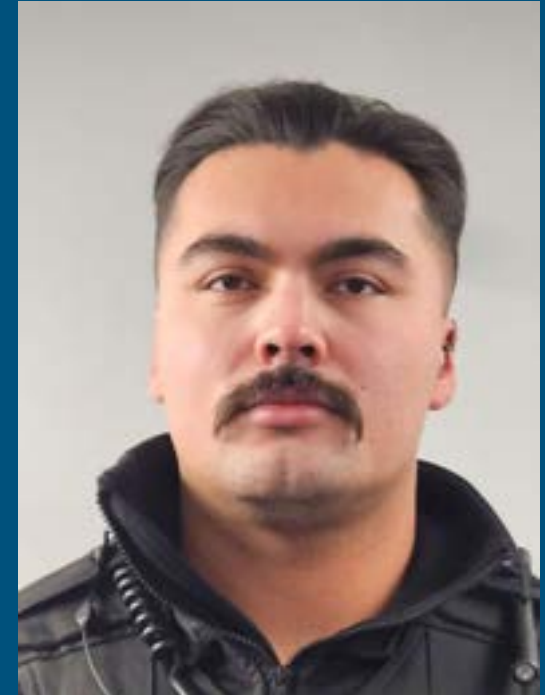

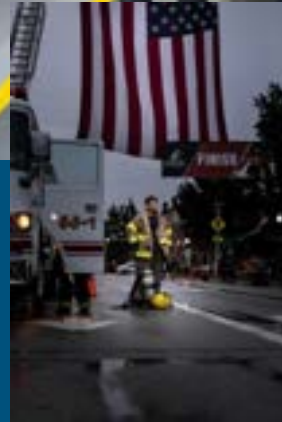
