Other details below

This is a **List** of all the **Roads** that will be **Closed** for the Jump & Fun Run / Walk

Longacre at Lazywood - **10:00 AM** until end of Jump

During the Run Walk event beginning at 11:50 AM all of Beachside will be closed until the end of the Run/Walk approximately 1:15 PM.

INTERSECTIONS: Beachside at Bass Bay; at Heather Hedge; at Cottage Cove;;at Richard; at Shadow Shore; at Willowood; at CloverCliff; at Brookshore; At Park Lake Dr.; at Craggy Creek; at Northvale; at Shorefield; Lee Lore from Beachside to Chippewa Rd. (Runners turn around at Lee Lore & Chippewa Rd.)

Notes:

* All of Lee Lore is closed during the Run Walk from Beachside to Chippewa Road.

- * All other roads listed above are open from Chippewa Road.
- * Bungalow Bay / Shuttle Bus Drop Off Zone - road is open but due to heavy pedestrian traffic and shuttle bus drop off accessibility will be slow going. Event parking at CrossPointe Oaks, and Church at the Lake
- * Beachside at Bass Bay (handicap parking). May be closed/blocked earlier if Emergency vehicles park there.
- * Point Park Parking lot exit to Beachside will be closed during the Run Walk.
- * Heavy pedestrian traffic on Longacre, Bungalow Bay, The Village Inn Parking Lot
 - * There will be increased pedestrian traffic throughout the Village on the day of the event.
- * Parking at the Beach Parking lot on the day of the event is not permitted until after the event has ended and cleared by event organizers.
