Drop offs are taken at Central Processing Facility, 8700 Lake Rd. All disposal is free of Charge- Items included are general trash, scrap metal, old furniture, fluorescent bulbs, computers, printers, two TVs and/ or monitors, batteries, used oil (oil only- no mixtures), old yard equipment (fuel tanks must be empty), and up to 4 passenger tires. NO APPLIANCES or PAINT. More than 4 tires is \$1.50 each, and more than 2 TV/ monitors is \$5, each. Document shredding is available.

As part of our clean-up day activities, we encourage you to bring one pound (small) jars of peanut butter to be donated to Feeding Medina County. FMC distributes approximately 1,000 weekend food bags throughout Medina County schools every Friday. Small jars of peanut butter are easy to pack into the bags while providing a lot of nutrition for food insecure children in our county
