

WATER CONDITIONS AT CHIPPEWA LAKE

The following is an email letter sent to registered boat owners at Chippewa Lake from the Medina Parks Dep't. Since not everyone has a boat, I am enclosing it for your information. Contact the Parks Department if you have questions.

Dear Chippewa Lake Boaters,

In consideration of the upcoming Independence Day holiday and the dramatic decline in algal toxins based on this week's water test, the Elevated Recreational Public Health Advisory has been removed from Chippewa Lake. Normal boating and water use activities may resume.

However, a warning remains for children, pregnant or nursing women, individuals with certain medical conditions, and pets to avoid contact with the water, per state health guidelines.

The most recent water samples taken June 26 showed toxin levels of 2.02 parts per billion, down significantly from levels of 22.3 ppb on June 19. Medina County Park District will continue to monitor water conditions as needed. If toxin levels remain below 6 ppb following the next test, all warnings will be lifted.
