WATERCRAFT STICKER, BOAT RAMP KEY, PARKING, and LAKE ACCESS PASS APPLICATION

2018

Dear Resident,

- The locks on the boat ramp gates will NOT be changed in 2018. If you have a new boat, are new to the community or did not obtain your key/sticker last year, you may complete the application located on the Chippewa Lake website. The ramp key and watercraft sticker costs will be \$15/key and \$5/sticker and are REQUIRED for utilizing our boat ramp.
- Lake Access (beach) pass for each family@ \$35, which includes parking at Lake Access (beach) and all village parks.
- Parking passes are required to park at any of our village parks (Pochedley, Point Park and Bungalow Bay-this does not include the Lake access parking lot). One parking pass per family will be allowed at no charge. If you already have a Resident Parking Pass, you do NOT need a new one, as they are not dated and do not expire. Officers will begin ticketing parking violations after Memorial Day weekend if no parking pass is displayed.

SAVE TIME!

In order to assist residents in obtaining new ramp keys, watercraft stickers, Lake Access passes and Parking passes, the Ramp Committee is offering **RENEWAL by MAIL**, as well as one public sale date.

The Sale date is:

- Saturday, April 28, 2018 from 9 AM – 11 AM at the Community Center (24 Circle Crest)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAIL RENEWAL

- Fill out the attached application. There is only one application for watercraft stickers/gate key, Lake Access pass and parking pass.
- Watercraft sticker/ key **RENEWALS** which have same owner, address and watercraft **ONLY** need the application (no document copies).
- For **NEW** watercraft, property or owner must **INCLUDE COPIES** of documents as indicated on the application.
- Attach check or money order, made out to the Village of Chippewa Lake, and mail it to Village of Chippewa Lake, PO Box 25, Chippewa Lake, OH 44215.
- Your stickers, passes, ramp key, etc. will be mailed to you.

Just a reminder, while the lake is public, our boat ramp is not. Attempting to put a watercraft in the lake via our ramp without a current Chippewa Lake Village lake access sticker, giving your key (or opening the gate with your key) for anyone else, or loaning or giving your sticker/key to any other individual will result in a fine and a revocation of ramp privileges.

Please display your watercraft sticker at all times on the back of the transom above the water line and to the right (starboard) side of the watercraft centerline as you stand in back of the boat looking at the transom. The sticker shall be in clear view without obstruction at all times.
